

OLHA PALAZHCENKO — MEZZO-SOPRANO

Olha Palazhchenko is a Ukrainian-born mezzo-soprano based in Dublin, Ireland, and a current member of the Irish National Opera Studio. She is known for her dark, low-lying mezzo-soprano timbre and a strong affinity for dramatic repertoire, including works by Verdi, Wagner, and verismo composers.

Her roles include Olga (*Eugene Onegin*), Ježibaba (*Rusalka*), Romeo (*I Capuleti e i Montecchi*), Fenena (*Nabucco*), Maffio Orsini (*Lucrezia Borgia*), Dalila (*Samson et Dalila*), and Suzuki (*Madama Butterfly*). She regularly performs with Irish National Opera in both operatic productions and concert projects.
